THESE ITEMS WILL BE KEPT FOR A PERIOD OF 60 DAYS, AFTER WHICH THEY WILL BE DISPOSED.

**• GUIDELINES RELATED TO CRYPTS AND NICHE •
• MEMORIALIZATION IN THE MAUSOLEUMS •**

In order to allow for personal memorialization and to maintain the appearance of the mausoleums, the following guidelines related to the memorialization of crypts and niches must be followed by all.

1. Please note that only artificial flowers are permitted inside the mausoleums. Real flowers may be used outside the mausoleums.
2. Floral arrangements must be placed inside the bronze vase and kept within the perimeter of the crypt or niche.
3. Up to two (2) small personal mementos (no more than 3" in overall size for crypts and 2" in overall size for niches) may be allowed if incorporated into the floral arrangement. Examples of this can be a small wallet photo, medallion or ribbon.
4. One traditional rosary wrapped around the light or vase is acceptable.
5. No pictures may be attached to the crypt or niche except those supplied by the cemetery.
6. Cards/poems may only be displayed for durations of one week prior to, and one week after the following occasions: Christmas, Easter, Mother's Day and Father's Day. For birthdays, wedding or death anniversaries, please indicate that date on the front of the card in order to alert cemetery staff (same time duration applies).
7. Floral arrangements or statues are sometimes placed on the tables throughout the mausoleums for special occasions. Please attach the name of the deceased to the arrangement or statue. Only one (1) floral arrangement or statue is allowed per deceased. They may be removed at the discretion of our cemetery staff. Please do not place any items on the floor inside the mausoleums or on the ground outside the mausoleums.

All other attachments to the crypt or niche which are not covered under the aforementioned guidelines will be removed and available for pick-up at our Heavenly Rest Cemetery office. These items will be kept for a period of 60 days, after which they will be disposed. The cemetery assumes no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to items removed from the mausoleums under these circumstances.

These guidelines are presented as part of our by-laws and established in order to clarify to all parties the restrictions of memorialization inside and outside the mausoleums.
